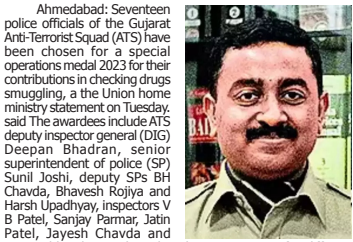


17 Gujarat ATS cops awarded special operation medal



Ahmedabad: Seventeen police officials of the Gujarat Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) have been chosen for special operations medals 2023 for their contributions in checking drug smuggling, a Union Home ministry statement on Tuesday. The awardees include ATS deputy inspector general (DIG) Deepan Bhadrani, senior superintendent of police (SP) Sunil Joshi, deputy SPS BH Chavda, Bhavesh Rojiva and Harsh Upadhyay, inspectors V B Patel, Sanjay Parmar, Jatin Patel, Jayesh Chavda and Hasmukh Bharwad, sub-inspectors B H Korat, R B Rana and Komal Vyas; wireless sub-inspectors Murali Shah, Kirpa Goletar, Rupal Rathod and Dipesh Chaudhary.

Along with the ATS cops, former inspector with the special operations group, M C Chaudhary, and two from Delhi police, sub-inspector Anil Dnaka and assistant sub-inspector Anil Chadha, are also on the list of awardees for assisting Gujarat ATS in their operations in 2022. The award, instituted in 2018, has been announced for special operations in areas such as counter-terrorism, border action, arms control, prevention of narcotics smuggling, and rescue operations. Through eight operations during 2022, Gujarat ATS seized 463.2kg of heroin, 313.9kg of pure methamphetamine powder and 80.2kg of liquid mephedrone and apprehended 67 individuals including 40 Pakistani nationals, three Afghan and 24 Indian nationals for their involvement in the narcotics trafficking network.

In joint operations, Gujarat ATS had contributed to seizure of nearly 424kg of heroin and opium in five different cases registered with other agencies.

Two special operations conducted by the CRPF in Jharkhand and a nationwide crackdown by the NIA on the Popular Front of India have been chosen for the Union Home Ministers' Special Operation Medal for 2023. A total of 204 security personnel, including CRPF, NIA, NBC, and police from various states, have been recognized for their contributions to counter-terrorism, border action, arms control, narcotics prevention,

and rescue operations. The operations resulted in the elimination, arrest, or surrender of Naxal leaders, as well as the seizure of arms and drugs.

A Jammu and Kashmir Police officer, Inspector Masroor Wani, was critically injured after being shot by terrorists while playing cricket with local boys in downtown Srinagar. He was immediately taken to the hospital and his condition is reported to be critical. Security forces have initiated a search operation in response to the attack. Senior superintendent of police (SSP) Ashok Kumar Meena has initiated a departmental inquiry against inspector Rajesh Kumar Singh, who was involved in the NRI murder case of September 2016. The action comes after accusations of "shoddy investigation and accepting bribes from the accused." Singh's leadership is being put under scrutiny for rewarding diligent workers with greater responsibilities, while those who have been inactive will be replaced, allowing new talent to assume these roles.

The party intends to make new appointments, initially for the roles of city and district presidents, followed by appointments to other organizational positions.

Gohil, Amit Chavda to meet leaders in Delhi

Kanu Desai to lead Chennai VGGs roadshow

Gandhinagar: State finance minister Kanu Desai will lead a delegation to Chennai on November 2 to promote the upcoming tenth edition of the Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit (VGGs), which will be held in Gandhinagar from January 10 to 12.

Before Chennai, the Gujarat government conducted similar roadshows in major cities, including Delhi, Mumbai and Chandigarh, as part of its efforts to amplify the reach and impact of the upcoming flagship business and investment summit.

Desai will address a gathering of leading industrialists and business leaders at the event highlighting the achievements made during the past two decades of the VGGs, an official statement said. Candidates who apply to join the administration will be selected based on their ability and paid a stipend of Rs 1 lakh per month.

White collar crimes more dangerous, says CBI court

Ahmedabad: While convicting a banker and a distributor of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOCL) for corruption and cheating causing a loss to the banking institution and the PSU, a special CBI court observed that white collar crimes are more dangerous for society and the nation because their impact is more severe than that of ordinary crimes. The case involved four persons - IOCL deputy manager Ganesha Venkataramanna; the manager of Bank of India's industrial estate branch in Ankleshwar, Raski Patel; an assistant bank manager Gunvant Vasava and an IOCL distributor named Milan Shah. They were accused of criminal conspiracy in 1999-2000, by forging letters of credit and bank guarantees and procuring goods from IOCL on credit, causing a loss of Rs 85 lakh to the PSU. While Vasava died during the 23 years the case was pending, Venkataramanna was acquitted by the CBI court.

The court held Patel and Shah guilty, and punished Patel with five years in prison and Shah with six. The court imposed a Rs 9 lakh fine on the banker and manager and Rs 85 lakh on Shah, equal to the loss caused to the PSU. The court said though the value of the fraud at present would be about Rs 12 crore, looking at the condition of the accused, the court imposed a fine of Rs 85 lakh. While sentencing the 85 lakh, special CBI judge D A Vora last week observed that the perpetrators of white-collar crimes are from the middle class, professionals and high-level officials. Such offences smother the development of the nation and its progress. Such offences are committed by educated people in a calculated and dispassionate manner and they continue to live in society without any loss of status or humiliation. The court further said that white-collar offences are more dangerous for society and the nation because their impact is more severe than that of ordinary offences, because they reduce the confidence and moral standards of the people.
