WR Runs Total 1228 To Carry 18.47 Lakh Migrants To Their Hometowns



Ahmedabad, Western Railway has operated total 1228 SHRAMIK SPL trains from 2nd May, 2020 to 18th June, 2020, which have carried approx. 18.47 lakh migrant labourers & their families to their desired destinations. Indian Railway's decision to run Shramik Special trains has benefitted and proved to be a boon to lakhs of migrant workers and their families. In continuation to this, 2 more shramik special trains departed from Gujarat on 18th June, 2020.

According to a press release issued by Shri Ravinder Bhakar - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, out of the 1228 Shramik special trains, maximum trains were bound for Uttar Pradesh followed by Bihar. The special Shramik trains were also operated to states of Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Gujarat, Manipur, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Assam and Maharashtra. Approx. 18.47 lakh passengers have been ferried by Western Rly

to their home towns in different states of the country, from 2nd May, 2020 to 18th June, 2020. Shri Bhakar stated that these Shramik Special trains have helped in facilitating faster movement of stranded labourers and their families to their native places. On 18th June, 2020, two Shramik special trains left from Gujarat. One train left from Surat to Pratapgarh in Uttar Pradesh and the other train left from Sabarmati to Howrah. From 3rd May to 18th June, 2020, a total of 187 Shramik Special Trains have originated from various stations under Mumbai Suburban Section, including 68 Shramik special trains from Bandra Terminus, 73 from Borivali, 31 from Vasai Road, 2 from Dahanu Road and 13 from Palghar station. These trains were departed for Gorakhpur, Jaunpur, Gonda, Varanasi, Pratapgarh, Bhagalpur, Prayagraj, Darbhanga, Danapur, Howrah etc. Out of these 1228 trains, Mumbai division has operated highest 715 trains, Ahmedabad division 200, Vadodara division 160, Bhavnagar division 30, Rajkot division 117 and Ratlam

division 6 Shramik special trains. These special trains are being operated by maintaining all social distancing norms, as well as proper thermal screening of passengers, is also being ensured before boarding the train. During the journey, passengers are also being given free meals and packaged drinking water.

Shri Bhakar stated that since 22nd March till 18th June, 2020, total 6726 rakes of goods trains have been used by WR to supply essential commodities amounting to 13.72 million tonnes. 13,330 freight trains have been interchanged with other zonal railways, in which 6678 trains were handed over and 6652 trains taken over at different interchange points. 347 Millennium Parcel rakes of Parcel Vans/ Railway Milk

Tankers (RMTs) have been sent to different parts of the country to supply as per the demands of essential items such as milk powder, liquid milk and other general consumer goods. Shri Bhakar further added that on 19th June, 2020 a parcel special train left from Porbandar to Shalimar.

Modi's statement on India-China standoff baffling: Cong



New Delhi: A day after Prime Minister Narendra Modi asserted that Chinese troops did not intrude into Indian territory, Congress leader and former Finance Minister P. Chidambaram on Saturday slammed the government saying his remarks have left everyone baffled and bewildered. He said that the statement of the Prime Minister contradicts earlier statements made by Chief of Army Staff General M.M. Naravane, Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar.

Addressing a press conference through video conferencing, Chidambaram said, 'I wish to begin by reiterating what the Congress President Sonia Gandhi said yesterday at the all party meeting. She said that the Congress stands by our defence forces and are prepared to make any sacrifice to ensure they are battle ready.' Chidambaram said that at the end of the meeting, the Prime Minister made his concluding remarks. 'These remarks have left practically everyone baffled and

bewildered. The Prime Minister said that no outsider was inside Indian territory in Ladakh,' the Congress leader said.

Lambasting the Prime Minister, Chidambaram said, 'It is quite obvious that the Prime Minister's statement contradicts the earlier statements made by the Chief of Army Staff, the Defence Minister and the Foreign Minister. The Congress leader said that if the Prime Minister's statement reflects the correct position, we would like to ask the government a few questions. 'If no Chinese troops had crossed the Line of Actual Control (LAC) and are in Indian territory, what was the face-off on May 5-6, 2020? Between May 5 and June 6, what was the issue on which local Indian commanders were talking to their Chinese counterparts? What was the subject matter of the negotiations between the Corps Commanders of the two countries on June 6?' he said firing salvos at Modi. Referring to the killing of 20 Indian soldiers in Ladakh's Galwan valley by the Chinese People Liberation's Army (PLA) troops in an unprecedented attack on Monday night, Chidambaram said, 'We would also like to ask, if no Chinese troops were inside Indian territory, where did the clashes take place on June 15-16? Where were 20 Indian soldiers killed and 85 injured?'

His remarks came a day after Modi categorically stated at the all-party meeting on the Chinese intrusion in the Galwan Valley and the killing of Indian soldiers that 'no Indian post or territory is

occupied by anyone.' The Prime Minister had emphasized that all necessary steps for national security and construction of necessary infrastructure will continue to be taken at a fast pace.

Modi had also reassured the leaders about the capability of the armed forces to defend the borders and said that they have been given a free hand to take all necessary steps. Sharpening the attack on the government, the Congress leader said, 'If no Chinese troops are in Indian territory, why did Foreign Minister S. Jaishankar's statement and other statements of MEA demand the restoration of status quo ante? What was the meaning of status quo ante? What was the meaning of the disengagement that the government said was underway? He also questioned that if no Chinese troops are inside Indian territory in Ladakh, why did 20 soldiers

have to make the supreme sacrifice. The Congress leader said that even after Modi's statement on Friday, China has blamed India for the clashes and has re-asserted its claim to the entire Galwan valley. 'What is the government's answer to this claim? Will the government reject this claim?' he questioned. Chidambaram questioned that when the Prime Minister said a few days ago that the sacrifice of our soldiers will not go in vain, what did he have in mind? 'Why and where did the soldiers sacrifice their lives, and how will the government ensure that the sacrifice will not be in vain?' he asked. He said the defence of the nation and its territorial integrity are dear to the heart of every Indian. 'We therefore seek answers to the questions with a view to re-double our commitment and present a picture of unity and solidarity,' Chidambaram added.

CM Gehlot emerges taller after ensuring win of two Congress candidates in RS polls



Rajasthan, As a child and then as a youth, Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot helped his father, who was a professional magician, perform magic shows and in the process mastered the art of magic. Magic taught him many things and one of this was to keep his political adversaries guessing. When the results of the three seats of the Rajya Sabha election was declared, his political detractors hailed the master strategist on how he achieved his goal. The result was along expected lines: Congress won two seats and the BJP one. Gehlot did not allow the

game plan of the BJP to succeed. The BJP tried to divide the Congress by fielding a second preference candidate - Onkar Singh Lakhawat - when it had votes that could win only one seat. But an alert Gehlot managed to keep the flock together and destroyed the BJP's dreams by blowing their cover. 'The BJP tried to repeat its Karnataka, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh act in Rajasthan. But the conspiracy did not work because the Congress MLAs were not lured by the offers made to them. The Congress MLAs were kept in a hotel where we managed to drive home the point that the BJP was trying to murder democracy and we should stand united against it. The idea of keeping the MLAs together was to drill morality into them and also their responsibility to the party on whose ticket they won their Vidhan Sabha elections,' said Gehlot.

One More Policeman Surrenders To Pandemic



New Delhi, Maratha land Maharashtra which has already turned out as the worst-affected state in the country with the deadly impact of the contagious disease has another unwanted record in its kitty. Amid this tense situation, a cop working with the Maharashtra Police Department succumbed to the dreaded virus and the total fatalities in the police department in connection with the virus rose to 46. The policeman who lost his life today was admitted to the famous King Edward Memorial

Hospital in Mumbai and has been receiving treatment for the past 10 days. Looking at the cases in the state, Maharashtra reported 3,827 fresh cases of the virus in the past 24 and the total toll of the cases rose to 1,24,331. To date, the state registered 5,893 fatalities in connection with the virus. Rahul Gandhi should rise above petty politics: Amit Shah

New Delhi: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday hit back at former Congress president Rahul Gandhi over his statement on face-off between Indian and Chinese soldiers in Galwan Valley in Ladakh and advised him to rise above 'petty politics'. Putting a video of the father of an injured army man on his Twitter account, Shah said, Gandhi should stand in solidarity with national interest by shunning his politics over the issue at a time when the whole nation is united. 'A brave armyman's father speaks and he has a very clear message for Mr Gandhi. At a time when the entire nation is united, Mr Rahul Gandhi should also rise above petty politics and stand in solidarity with national interest,' Shah tweeted. Shah's remark came after Rahul Gandhi in a fresh tweet accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi of surrendering Indian territory to China. 'PM has surrendered Indian territory to Chinese aggression. If the land was Chinese: 1. Why were our

soldiers killed? 2. Where were they killed?,' Gandhi tweeted. The video of the father of an injured soldier shows him saying, 'Indian Army is a very strong army and has the ability to defeat China and other foreign countries. Rahul Gandhi should not do politics on the issue. My son fought and will continue fighting in the army'. Gandhi had on Friday re-tweeted a video of the father with a comment that cabinet ministers were lying about the violent face-off with Chinese troops on June 15 night in the Galwan Valley in Ladakh on the Line of Actual Control (LAC).
